Who is the course for?

The course is aimed at ELT teachers and teacher trainers who wish to learn about Blended Learning

Course Aims

- To introduce participants to the concept of Blended Learning (BL) in the context of language learning
- To compare a range of approaches to BL involving different materials and learning platforms
- To encourage participants to explore the pedagogical rationale behind BL courses
- To present a 'framework' to allow participants to create BL courses appropriate for their own teaching situation

Outcomes

By the end of this course, participants will be:

- familiar with a number of definitions of the term Blended Learning
- familiar with a number of approaches to the term Blended Learning
- aware of the features of a range of common learning platforms
- aware of a common range of digital material created for language learning
- aware of what is involved in creating their own digital exercises for language learning
- able to plan a series of language lessons which take a blended approach to teaching
- able to apply a 'framework' for creating BL courses appropriate for their own teaching situation

Course length: 20 hours

[4x1 hour webinars + approx. 4 hours online work / reading per week excl. assignment]

Participants will submit a short assignment in order to receive a **Certificate of completion**. To receive your certificate, you should complete 80% of the coursework, including the final assignment.
